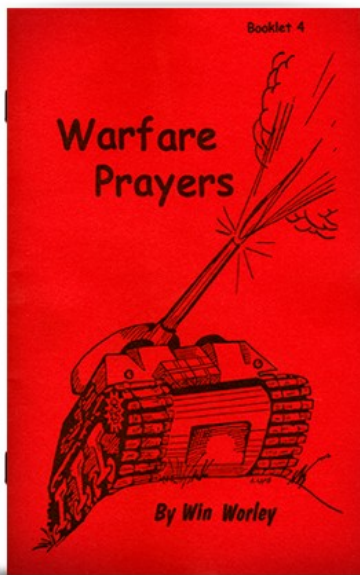


# Renunciation of Pride
